

Shruti is what has been revealed by God Himself sacred text that is called Shruti is unquestionable and canonical in nature. Chanting of Vedas during temple festivals is called BRAHMOTHSAVAM.

Vedha says: "Dharmo Rakshathi Rakshithaha" - Bramashri T.G. Subramania Ganapatigal Founder of T.S.G.V. Sabha was born in Thiruvengadu / (Swetharanya) had performed vedaparayanam and Maharudram for 43 years with an unfinching faith in Thiruvengadu and in between an year he had also performed ATHIRUDHRAM for the welfare of the humanity. He performed Vedaparayanam & Maharudram in many places like Kasi, Chidambaram, Thiruvannamalai, Swamimalai, Kanchi etc. On the concluding day of the Vedaparayanam at Kanchi, on 1-3-1986, Bramasri Subramania Ganapatigal attained MOKSHA at Kanchi itself. This Kainkarya is continued uninterruptedly till date by his son Sri. S. Chandran as ordained by his Holiness Paramacharya.

From 2011, Thiruvengadu Vedaparayana Sabha is transformed into a Registered body under the name of T.S.G.V. Religious Trust.

Sri Subramania Ganapatigal had conducted the Vedaparayanam, Maharudra Yagnam every year consecutively for 43 years (1938 to 1981) at Thiruvengadu. From 1982 to 2021 (44th year to 84th Year) his son, Sri Chandrasekharan (a) Chandran continued the legacy of his father to conduct the vedaparayanam in various places of India every year.

In the year 1939 which was the 2nd year of the yagna, the founder Brahmasri Thiruvengadu Subramania Ganapatigal met his Holiness MAHA PERIYAVA, Sri Paramacharya while he was camping Melur in Tanjore Dist. to seek his blessings. Paramacharya not only blessed him but also expressed his desire to him continue this yagna for many more years, more than 100 years. As per the blessings of Sri Maha Periyava, the yagna is being continued by Sri Subramania Ganapatigal's Son Sri Chandran, Sri Sankaran in various kshethras and the present one is the 86th year of Celebration.

HISTORY OF KUMBAKONAM

Kumbakonam Kshetram with the mythological name Bhaskara Kshetram is located on the banks of the Holy River Kaveri. This land, which is mentioned in Devar hymns as "Kudanthai Keezhkottam" has many Mahans and Shiva Vishnu Madams (Advaita Dwaita Vishishtadvaita). After the biggest Deluge, the world became united with Lord Shiva, the seeds needed for the coming ages were placed in a nectar pool and it properly decorated and floated thrice untill the end of the whole world. It is in the local history that when "Sri Rudhrar" took the guise of "Kiratha Murti" and broke the kumbam with his weapon, the Amruta Bindu. i.e. a small amount of water fell from the amruta channel, one became the "Mahamaga Pond" and the other became the "Portamarai Pond". There is a separate sanctum as Sri Mangalampa Sannati in Kumbeswarar Temple for "Kiratha Murti" and Kanchi Mutt is credited for erecting the shrine. The above was engraved in the inscription as per the request of Shri Maha Periyava to the Kanagabhisheka Committee.

Our Sankara Mutt plays an important role in Kumbakonam Kshetra which has many glories, merit and history

The proof that this mutt has been funtioning for more than 350 years is that, our 62nd, 63rd and 64th aacharyas Brindhavan is located in Vadakodi of Sankara mutt and called as the "Vadakodi Brindhavan". There are many Shiva Temples around this shrine and those temples also have an ancient connection)Its called as Jyotir Lingam) such as, kumbeswarar, Panapureeswarar Madivanam, Naganathaswamy, Someswarar, Thiru Kalahastheeswarar, Gauthameswarar, Kottayur Kotteswarar, Abhimugeswarar / Kasi Viswanathar.

Rangantha as Charangapani and Chakrapani as Sudarsana Raja have been enshrined here in the same town. Further, the Masi Maha Utsavam is becoming a world famous in this town. It is a great blessing to have great Mahans visiting this place and to conduct Vedhaparayanam, Maharuthrayagam, Rikveda Samhita Homam, Pournamasa Ishti, Sri Sudarsanayagam, Sri Radha Kalyanam in such as Kshetram.
